Economic & Market Developments

- The NFIB Small Business Optimism Index increased 1.4 points in the month of August to 100.2. This is above the 46 year average of the index, but still well below the pre-COVID level in February. The Uncertainty Index came in at 90 for August, an increase of 2.
- Mortgage rates hit fresh all-time lows last week with the 30-year rate at 2.86% and the 15-year at 2.37%.
- The number of job openings in July increased 6.6 million, exceeding expectations of 6 million. The largest increase in openings was seen in retail trade, health care and social assistance, and construction.
- Weekly Initial Jobless Claims increased 3,000 to 884,000. While still showing a declining trend, the rate of improvement has slowed over the past month.


