Economic & Market Developments

- The NFIB Small Business Optimism Index improved to 95.8 in February, up from 95.
- The Core CPI Inflation Rate increased 0.4% in February and 1.3% year-over-year. This was slightly below expectations at 1.4%.
- Initial Unemployment Claims came in at 712 thousand, beating expectations of 725 thousand. This is the lowest weekly claims number since November.
- JOLTs Job Openings were 6.917 million in January, will above consensus estimates of 6.6 million.
- The University of Michigan's Consumer Sentiment Index improves substantially, moving up to 83 from the previous month at 76.8. This was well above expectations at 78.5.


